What is Living Sacrifice Immerse?

Living Sacrifice Immerse is an 8-month leadership, discipleship, and ministry formation experience for young adults ages 18–25 who desire to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ and grow as leaders in their church, community, and everyday life.

Based at camp, participants live in intentional Christian community from September through May, with accommodation and meals provided. Through mentorship, discipleship, retreats, leadership development, practical skills training, and hands-on ministry opportunities, participants are immersed in an environment that encourages spiritual growth, personal development, and active service.

Living Sacrifice Immerse exists to cultivate spiritually mature, mission-minded young adults who are committed to following Christ and serving others. Participants are challenged to grow in their faith, discover and develop their God-given gifts, and gain practical experience that prepares them for future leadership opportunities.

More than a program, Immerse is a community. Living and serving alongside peers creates opportunities to build lasting friendships, develop valuable life skills, and grow in confidence as participants discern God's direction for their lives and learn to live out their faith with purpose.

Participants can discover God's direction for their lives and be equipped to serve Him wherever He leads.

Immerse Components:

- Spiritual formation through discipleship, Bible study, prayer, worship, and spiritual disciplines
- Intentional Christian community living with accommodations and meals provided.
- One-on-one mentorship and leadership coaching
- Weekly small groups and personal growth opportunities
- Leadership development through training, workshops, and practical experience
- Ministry involvement in local corps, camps, and community settings
- Hands-on leadership opportunities at youth and young adult events
- Practical life skills training, including communication, conflict resolution, budgeting, and teamwork
- Professional certifications and workplace skill development
- Team-building activities and outdoor leadership experiences

- Identity, calling, and character development from a biblical perspective
- Training in emotional intelligence, resilience, and healthy self-care practices
- Opportunities to serve alongside experienced ministry leaders
- Retreats, conferences, and special leadership development events
- Capstone leadership projects and ministry experiences
